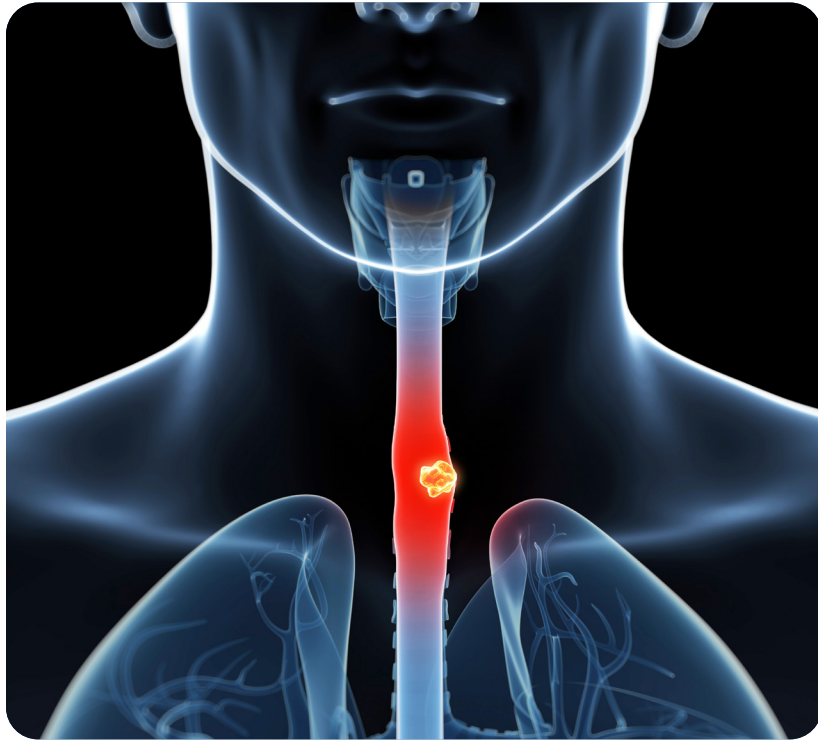

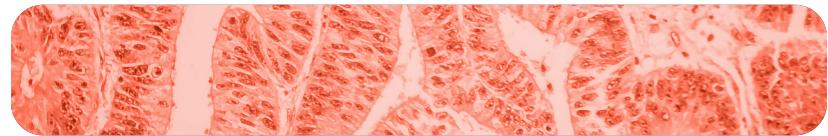

Course Description

This interdisciplinary conference brings together an expert faculty to present on the clinical management and research of patients with esophageal cancers. This will include the latest approaches to detection and risk prediction. Sessions will also look at the roles of both adjuvant and proton therapies, along with the role of clinical trials.

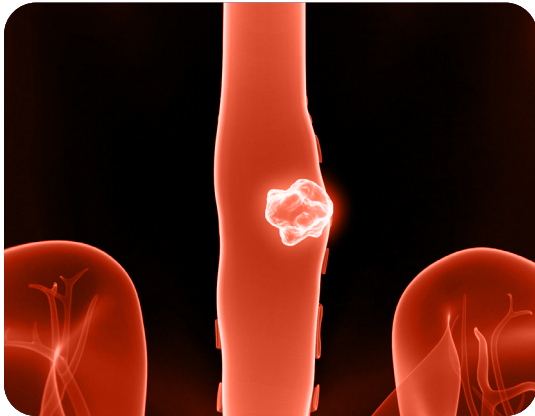
