Course Description

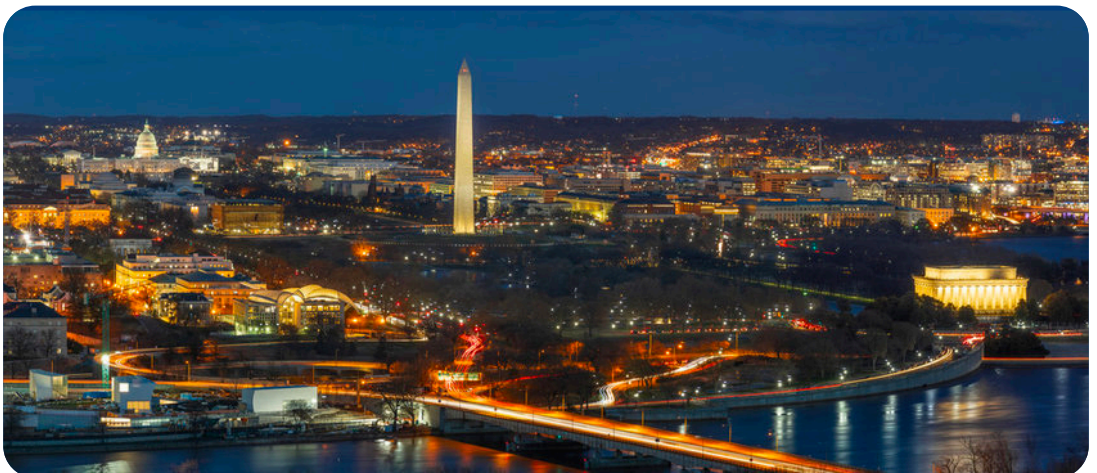

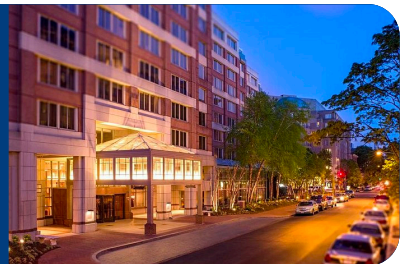
Cancellation Policy
