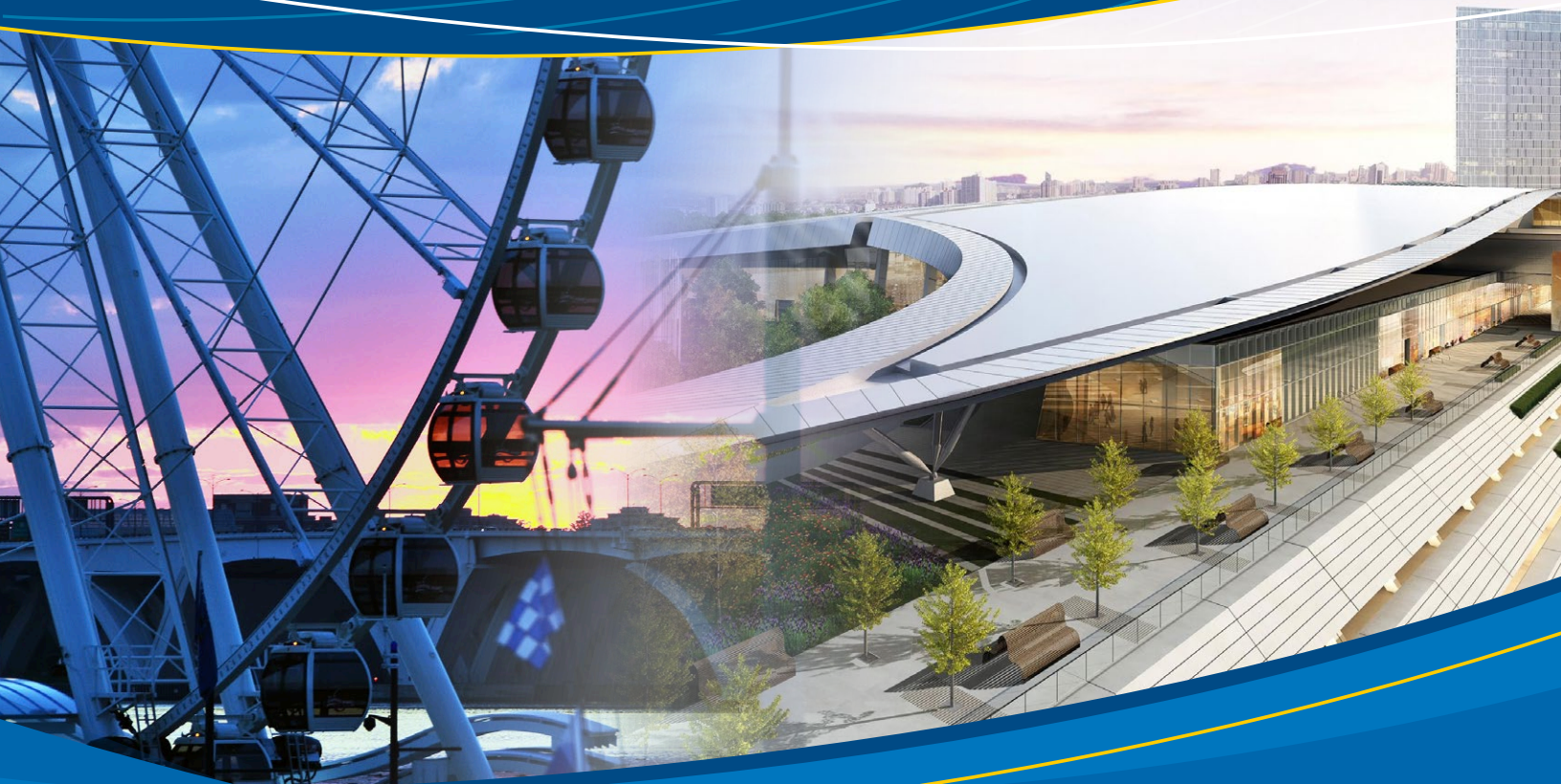

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Continuing research and expanding therapeutic options have improved the prevention and treatment of cardiovascular disease. 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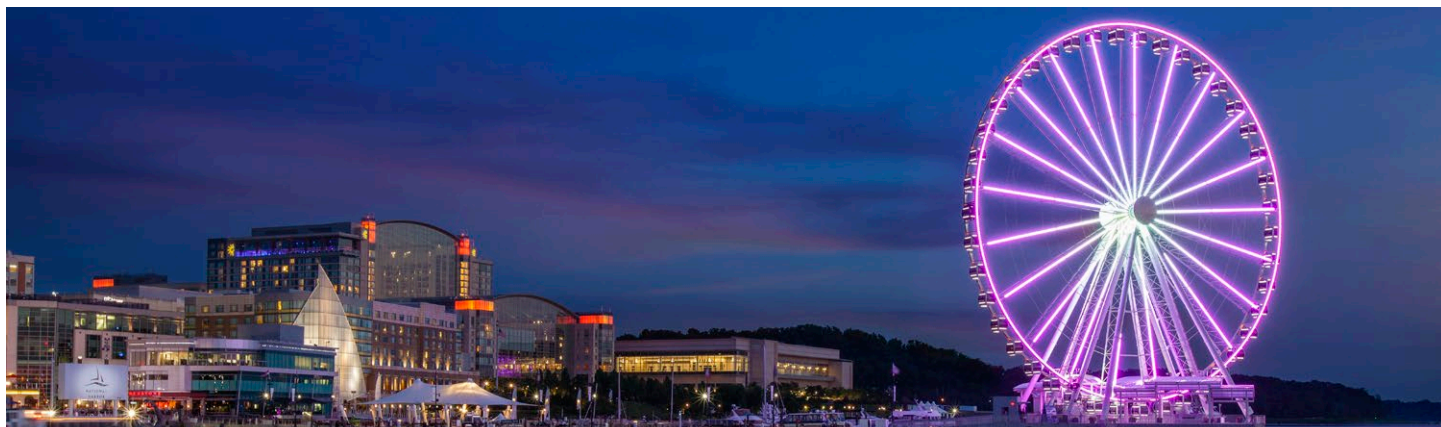
